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Alameda County Public Health Officer Statement Regarding Visitation in Alameda County Long-Term Care Facilities (LTCFs)

I, the Alameda County Health Officer, am issuing this Statement to clarify guidance related to visitation in Alameda County LTCFs.

ACPHD is aligned with the guidance provide by CMS and CDPH regarding visitation in LTCFs. We expand on that guidance specifically to SNFs to include all LTCFs in Alameda County.

In conjunction with state and federal guidance, indoor visits are allowed in Alameda County LTCFs if the facility has had no COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days and the Alameda County positivity rate is under 10% over the past 14 days. LTCFs are required to facilitate in-person visitation that is consistent with current regulations and guidance from CMS, CDPH, CDSS and CCL.

We understand the importance of maintaining contact with family and friends and remain hopeful that our community will help reduce and prevent the spread of COVID-19 to keep our County positivity rate below 10%.

If the county positivity rate exceeds 10%, in-person visitation would be suspended and only endof-life, virtual and outdoor visits are allowed and encouraged.
