<input type="checkbox"/> Request Consent forms and Patient Education forms from pharmacy and have available.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Clinical staff reviews list and identify cases that are potentially eligible for treatment considering: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ time since symptom onset ○ co-morbidities (liver, renal disease) ○ medications ○ other considerations 	Don't Delay: Test Soon and Treat Early (cdc.gov) Know Your Treatment and Prevention Options for COVID-19
<input type="checkbox"/> Have on ready a cumulative line list of residents who have had a pre-review for eligibility for treatment, and pre-counseling on treatments available.	
Steps for COVID Treatment Provision in RCFEs and ARFs	
<input type="checkbox"/> Test and isolate any resident or staff that has symptoms, Antigen Test preferred. PCR test if negative Antigen test; or repeat antigen test.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Identify staff/residents who test positive at beginning of each day (preferably through antigen testing), date of test collection.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Clinical staff at each facility reviews list and address who is potentially eligible for treatment considering: time since test positive, symptoms, co-morbidities (liver, renal disease), medications, and other considerations.	https://aspr.hhs.gov/COVID-19/Therapeutics/Documents/COVID-Therapeutics-Decision-Aid.pdf NIH COVID-19 Treatment Guidelines - Antivirals
<input type="checkbox"/> Contact each eligible resident's physician and/or nurse practitioner within 24 hours of test positivity to assist in review of eligibility. Provide treatment order form to prescriber.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Any resident who meets eligibility, ensure review of drug-drug interactions.	COVID-19 Drug Interaction Tool EUA fact sheet for ritonavir-boosted nirmatrelvir
<input type="checkbox"/> Counsel staff/residents who are eligible, and family members/caregivers if feasible, about treatments available.	
<input type="checkbox"/> For residents that are eligible, obtain signed consent from resident/person consenting for resident. Ensure completion of treatment order form, and receipt by pharmacist.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Complete patient checklist prior to treatment administration.	Paxlovid Patient Eligibility Screening Checklist Tool for Prescribers - FDA
