<input type="checkbox"/> Keep a list of residents who have had counseling on treatments available and possible eligibility	

### Checklist for COVID Treatment **Provision** in Long Term Care Facilities

<input type="checkbox"/> Test and isolate any resident or staff that has symptoms. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Antigen Test preferred.</li> <li>• PCR test if negative Antigen test; or repeat antigen test.</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Create list of staff/residents who test positive at beginning of each day and note date of test collection and date of symptom onset

<input type="checkbox"/> Contact each eligible resident's physician and/or nurse practitioner within 24 hours of test positivity to assist in review of eligibility.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Provide treatment order form to prescriber.

<input type="checkbox"/> Counsel staff/residents who are eligible, and family members/caregivers if feasible, about treatments available.	
<input type="checkbox"/> For residents that are eligible: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Obtain signed consent from resident/person consenting for resident.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Complete treatment order form and receipt by pharmacist.</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Obtain medication from pharmacy

<input type="checkbox"/> Monitor residents who have received treatments for symptoms or any change in condition.
