


COVID-19 Epidemic Key Points

- Daily case rate is 12.3 per 100,000
 - Adjusted Case Rate is 9.5 (Purple Tier)
- Hospitalized COVID cases 174 and falling
 - 53 in ICU
- Testing rates lower





Alameda County COVID-19 Daily Case Rate



Reported COVID-19 Cases, February 12 to February 21, 2021



Alameda County Shelter in Place

- Currently in Purple Tier
 - Red Tier possible in two weeks if trends continue
 - Tier changes announced Tuesdays and effective the next day
 - Red Tier: indoor dining, movies, museums, gyms; capacity limits
- Schools
 - K-6 schools may open now with approved safety plan
 - Middle and high school may open in Red Tier
 - Vaccination of staff and students not required for safe school operations
- Youth sports
 - State now allowing more outdoor sports when daily case rate <14



Vaccine Progress Key Points

- 14% of residents have received at least one dose
 - 49% of adults 65 and older receive at least one dose
 - Substantial numbers now fully vaccinated
- Highest vaccination rates among White and Asian residents
 - County Community PODs now focused on most impacted populations
- While vaccine supply remains limited, there are a number of locations where vaccinations are being provided to eligible residents and essential workers in Alameda County






Alameda County COVID-19 Vaccination Dashboard



















County Community Vaccine PODs


- 28,976 first doses through 2/19
 - 37,109 total doses
- Started with health care workers
- Now primarily older adults in most impacted zip codes

Alameda County Fairgrounds POD

- Soft Launch, Monday 2/15
 - Tested workflows, logistics
 - ~400 patients vaccinated
- Week 1 (2/15-2/20)
 - Over 5,300 vaccines total
 - County vaccinated over 3,080
- Week 2 (2/22 2/27)
 - Anticipate over 12,000 doses total
 - County plans over 6,000 (1000/day)







Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum POD

- Administering 6,000 doses/day
 - ~85% drive up access
 - ~15% pedestrian access
 - HCSA and CBO given access to set aside appointments
- Mobile Units
 - 2 mobile units
 - 250 doses/day/each
 - Sites to rotate weekly and return for 2nd doses in 3 weeks
 - Mon-Fri sites in priority neighborhoods in partnership with CBOs
 - Sat-Sun sites in partnership with faith-based organizations
 - This week:
 - Resilient Fruitvale at Native American Health Center
 - Center for Independent Living at Ed Roberts Center


