



COVID-19 Epidemic Key Points

- Daily case rate is 8.2 per 100,000
 - Adjusted Case Rate is 6.3
- Daily case reports may be leveling off
- Test positivity 2.4% overall and 3.7% in HPI 1
- Testing rates have declined
- Hospitalized COVID cases 152 and falling
 - 36 in ICU


Alameda County COVID-19 Daily Case Rate





Reported COVID-19 Cases, January 24 to February 2, 2021




Alameda County COVID-19 daily case rates, 7-day rolling average


Alameda County test rates per 100,000 residents, 7-day rolling average

Alameda County Shelter in Place

- Currently in Purple Tier but Red Tier likely next week
 - Indoor dining, movies, museums, gyms; capacity limits
- Schools
 - K-6 schools may open now with approved safety plan
 - Middle and high school may open in Red Tier
 - State plan would provide \$2B to incentivize opening by 3/31
 - K-2 in Purple; K-6 plus some MS and HS in Red
 - State push to vaccinate K-12 staff started 3/1




Vaccine Progress Key Points

- 22% of residents 16 and older have received at least one dose
 - 57% of adults 65 and older have received at least one dose
 - Roughly 100,000 doses to County residents in past week
- Highest vaccination rates among White residents
 - Improvements among all R/E groups
 - County Community PODs ongoing



California's Vaccination Prioritization: Phase 1b, Tier 1



Alameda County is now vaccinating:

- Health Care Workers
- People in Long Term Care Facilities
- People ages 65+
- Food/Agriculture/Restaurant/Grocery workers
- Emergency Services workers
- Education/Childcare workers



Within each category, prioritizing:

- Older adults
- MediCal or Uninsured
- Areas with very high COVID-19 case rates (HPI Q1 + priority zip codes)
- People with direct contact with clients or the public at work
- People who cannot work from home
- People with limited mobility








Vaccinated Alameda County Residents, Percent by Age Group (16+)

 - Union City – Tiburcio Vasquez
 - Coliseum Mobile Units

 - La Familia COVID Testing Site in Cherryland
- **Community PODs**
 - Fremont High School – Oakland Fruitvale
- **Emergency Services POD**
 - Office of Emergency Services – Dublin

State Vaccine Policy Update

- State prioritizing K-12 staff this week and next - 75,000 doses
 - Dedicated school staff testing days at Oakland Coliseum
 - Requiring local accounting of vaccine delivered to school staff
- Vaccine eligibility standardized across the state 3/1
 - No change in AC
- Blue Shield TPA: full management responsibility of vax distribution by 3/31
 - Alameda County in 3rd wave – 3/15; first meeting with TPA 3/5
 - TPA is already making allocation recommendations in first wave counties
 - Will be a contracted provider network, including LHJs
 - MyTurn required
 - Data, efficiency, incentives
