

# WHERE CAN I GET FREE VACCINES?



## If you have health insurance:

- Contact your healthcare provider or pharmacy.
  - Flu and COVID-19 vaccines are free for most people with private insurance, Medi-Cal or Medicare.
  - Check with your insurance about the cost of RSV vaccine.

## If you are uninsured OR your insurance doesn't cover the cost of the vaccines:

- **Adults and children can get free COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the [Family Justice Center](#).**
- **Adults can also get free COVID-19 vaccines through the [California Bridge Access Program](#).**
  - Visit [Alameda County Community Vaccination Clinics](#) for clinics offering California BAP vaccine in Alameda County.
- **Children can also get free COVID-19 vaccines through the Vaccines for Children Program.**

- Free RSV vaccines are currently not available through ACPHD.
