


#### **Federal CDC Recommendations**

#### **Statewide COVID-19 Vaccine Task Force**

- <u>Drafting Guidelines Workgroup</u>: develop allocation guidance for who will receive vaccine when supply is limited
- <u>Community Vaccine Advisory Committee</u>: advises State's Task Force on direction of task force workgroups

#### **Local Distribution**

#### Phase 1a -NOW

#### Health Care Workers

#### Tier 1

- Hospitals
- Dialysis
- EMTs
- Long-Term Care Facilities/Skilled Nursing

#### Tier 2

- Community Health Workers
- IHSS/Home Health Care
- Primary care, behavioral health, & specialty providers

#### Tier 3

- Dentists
- Blood Banks
- Pharmacy Staff

#### Phase 1b-NEXT

#### Tier 1

- Ages 65+
- Essential Workers
  - Education/Child Care
  - Emergency Services
  - Food/Agriculture

#### Tier 2

- Essential Workers
  - Transportation/ logistics
  - Industrial/ commercial/ Residential/ Sheltering
  - Critical manufacturing
- CongregateSettings
  - Incarcerated
  - Unhoused (unsheltered)

#### Phase 1c

- Essential Workers
  - Government/ Ops
  - Water/Waste/ Energy/Chemicals
- Ages 50+
- Ages 16-49 with underlying health conditions

#### Phase 2

 Moderate underlying health conditions

#### Phase 3

- Young Adults
- Children
- Workers not covered in phases 1 or 2

#### Phase 4

 Anyone who did not access
 Phases 1, 2 or 3

On 1/25/21, Governor Newsom announced that the State will transition to an age-based framework after Phase 1b Tier 1

## **State Framework Updates**

## Simplifying eligibility

- Move to age-based tiers after Phase 1b Tier 1
- Statewide standardized movement through tiers


#### Statewide vaccine administration network

- Third party administrator to handle allocations
- Direct allocations to health care providers: public health systems, pharmacies, health systems, public hospitals, community health centers, pharmacies and pop-up/mobile
- Standardized reporting for providers to support improved data

## Allocations to include equity focus

- Use of data to reallocate if not meeting equity targets
- Healthy Places Index

Doses received within Alameda County (excluding Berkeley)	102,750
Doses allocated to hospitals and other health care entities	63,725
Doses received by HCSA/PHD	39,025

Doses received by HCSA/PHD	39,025
Doses administered by HCSA/PHD	21,033
Percent of HCSA/PHD doses administered	54%
Doses to be administered by HCSA/PHD in the coming week	4,000

Doses received within Alameda County (excluding Berkeley)	102,750
First Doses	64,550
Second Doses	38,200

Approximate size of Phase 1a population in Alameda County – Now

145,000

Health care workers, long term care facility residents and staff

Approximate size of Phase 1b population in Alameda County – early February 420,000

>65 years old, education & childcare, emergency services, food/agriculture

#### Where will people get vaccinated?

- County points of distribution (PODs)
  - 2 operational now
  - 2 Mass Vaccination Sites (in planning)
  - Community-Based PODs (in planning)
- Health Care Providers (as supply increases)
  - Provider's office
  - Community Clinics
  - Urgent Care
  - Hospitals/Multi-County Entities (Kaiser, Sutter updates)







## Vaccination at County PODs, Phase 1a





#### **Doses Administerd by Age Group**




Vaccinations at Community Clinics, Phase 1a (Roots, Davis Street, Alameda Health Consortium) ~86-90% Persons of Color

#### **Doses Administered by Race/Ethnicity**




#### **Doses Administered by Gender**






### Alameda County COVID-19 weekly case rate

## Community/Neighborhood Points of Distribution (POD) Model

- Where: Quartile 1 Healthy Places Index (HPI), Disproportionate COVID-19 burden:
  - East Oakland/Fruitvale; Deep East Oakland, Ashland/Cherryland, South Hayward, West Oakland
- Timeline: 1<sup>st</sup> Community POD tentative 1<sup>st</sup> week of February others to follow
- Work with trusted partners and community anchors to identify appropriate sites & do targeted outreach & messaging
- Increase access & address hesitancy
