WHERE CAN I GET FREE VACCINES?



If you have health insurance:

- Contact your healthcare provider or pharmacy.
 - Flu and COVID-19 vaccines are free for most people with private insurance, Medi-Cal or Medicare.
 - Check with your insurance about the cost of RSV vaccine.

If you are uninsured OR your insurance doesn't cover the cost of the vaccines:

- Adults and children can get free COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the <u>Family Justice Center</u>.
- Adults can also get free COVID-19 vaccines through the <u>Bridge Access Program</u>.
 - Visit <u>vaccines.gov</u> or call **1-800-232-0233** to find a location.
 - Make sure you click the "Bridge Access Program Participant" box when booking your appointment.
- Children can also get free COVID-19 vaccines through the Vaccines for Children Program.
